



## Mission Possible Team Building Modules - Overview

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**Note:** Many of our modules marked **(K)** are based on the Kaizen model of continuous improvement

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| 1 | <b>Program Name: (K)</b> <b>ICE</b> (Infrared Combat Experience)<br><b>Description:</b> This is the latest combat game using infra red technology. It is completely safe and can be played by all ages. There are several games that can be played that are just great fun. Pulse pounding combat that feels for real. |
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| 2 | <b>Program Name:</b> <b>Jigsaw Puzzle Game</b> , Team Building Module<br><b>Description:</b> This is a Team Building ice breaker. |
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| 3 | <b>Program Name:</b> <b>Project Challenge</b> , Team Building Module<br><b>Description:</b> This is a Team Building challenge. The team select an envelope that has instructions inside. They have to follow the instructions to achieve their objective. |
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| 4 | <b>3 Part module - Compass Challenge + Uranium Toxic Waste + Machine.</b><br><b>Program Name:</b> <b>The Compass Challenge</b> is the first part of this three part integrated program. The total program takes around 1 hour to complete.<br><br><b>Description:</b> Teams are given a compass and instructed on how to use it. They then have to follow a compass bearing. This will be incorporated into a combined exercise with Uranium and Machine. |
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| 5 | <b>Program Name:</b> <b>Uranium Toxic Waste.</b> <i>This is the second part of this three part program.</i><br><b>Description:</b> The teams have to carry a bowl of toxic uranium, simulated by plastic balls, from one location to another without touching the bowl or the uranium. |
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| 6 | <b>Program Name:</b> <b>Machine.</b> <i>This is the third part of this three part program.</i><br><b>Description:</b> When the team have moved the uranium to the correct location, the teams have to build a machine from the parts provided to transfer the uranium into a safe location. |
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| 7 | <b>Program Name: (K)</b> <b>Kayak Basketball</b> , There will be an additional charge for the rental of the Kayaks.<br><b>Description:</b> This is an active game that has 2 teams in kayaks. |
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| 8 | <b>Program Name:</b> <b>Tire Ball</b> , an active competitive game<br><b>Description:</b> This game can be played on the beach or any other open area. |
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| 9 | <b>Program Name:</b> <b>Snorkel Treasure Hunt</b> , for swimmers.<br><b>Description:</b> This can be done in a pool or the sea. |
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- 10 **Program Name: (K) Limited Senses**, one way communication  
**Description:** The balance of the team will be blindfolded and guided through a maze or over obstacles by a leader.
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- 11 **Program Name: Deciphering**, how a team works in an intellectual challenge  
**Description:** Each team has to decipher an encrypted message and follow the instructions. They will have to find some items that contain information that they will need to complete their task.
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- 12 **Program Name: (K) Supply Chain**, what every company needs to work well  
**Description:** Each team member has a role to play in processing the "products" from the beginning to final delivery.
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- 13 **Program Name: Think to Unlink**, physical relationship building!!  
**Description:** The team are all connected together with ropes around their wrists.
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- 14 **Program Name: (K) Minefield**, communication many to one!!  
**Description:** Each team member has to pass through blindfolded, guided by the rest of the team.
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- 15 **Program Name: Building Bridges**, cooperation and planning  
**Description:** The team has to transfer the whole team over a toxic area of land without touching it and everyone must cross over.
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- 16 **Program Name: Semaphore Signaling**, the old fashioned way  
**Description:** A member of each team is given 2 flags, each team member has a part of a message.
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- 17 **Program Name: Pass the Tire**, cooperation and agility  
**Description:** Take two different style bicycle tires for each team. They have to pass the tires finishing with each tire at its starting position.
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- 18 **Program Name: Submarine Ball**, how to create a support system  
**Description:** This is a game in a pool or in the sea.
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- 19 **Program Name: Island Hopping**, how to cooperate and work as a unit  
**Description:** The team have to cross a swamp over 8 small islands and have only 1 plank of wood.
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- 20 **Program Name:** **Bucket Chain**, a team race that requires some strategy  
**Description:** This challenge can be done in a pool or in the open.
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- 21 **Program Name:** **Horse Race**, a challenge of communication and problem solving  
**Description:** The horse race is in several stages.
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- 22 **Program Name: (K)** **Team Batting Challenge**, skill and having fun as a team  
**Description:** This challenge can be carried out using a baseball bat or, for some players, a tennis racket.
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- 23 **Program Name: (K)** **Kayak Tug of War**, picking champions and supporting them  
**Description:** This challenge can be carried out using 2 double kayaks.
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- 24 **Program Name: (K)** **Disc Gymnastics**, creativity and integrity  
**Description:** This challenge is to bring out the creative and athletics ability of the players and also as a test of integrity.
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- 25 **Program Name: (K)** **Tarp Juggling**, communication and cooperation needed here  
**Description:** This challenge has 4 tarpaulins of equal size. They will be nominated with a color, Red, White, Blue and Green.
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- 26 **Program Name:** **Team Totem**, to see ourselves as others see us  
**Description:** This exercise is designed to run throughout the program and be presented before or at dinner in the evening.
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- 27 **Program Name:** **Ribbon Ceremony**, to show that small teams are still part of a big one  
**Description:** Each team chooses a numbered Ribbon.
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- 28 **Program Name:** **Rock and Roll**, the fun way to close a team building  
**Description:** This is also designed to run throughout the program to be done when the group has spare time.
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
